

Disable Autocomplete Function

(Previously Saved Passwords)

Internet Explorer

- 1. Click gearwheel (Top right corner)
- 2. **Select** Internet Options > Content > AutoComplete > Settings > Forms and Searches
 - Uncheck Usernames and passwords on Forms
 - Check Ask me before saving passwords
- 3. Click Delete AutoComplete History
 - o Uncheck everything EXCEPT Form Data and Passwords
 - o Click Delete (All passwords saved on Internet Explorer will be deleted)

Mozilla Firefox



- 1. **Click** Menu button (Top right corner)
- 2. **Select** Options > Privacy and Security > **Scroll** to the Logins and Passwords section
 - To stop the browser from saving login information for just WEST consin Credit Union
 - Click Exceptions and add westconsincu.org
 - o To stop the browser from saving login information for ALL sites
 - Uncheck Ask to Save Logins and Passwords for Websites
- 3. **Click** the Library button
 - Click History > Clear Recent History

Google Chrome



- 1. Click Menu Button (Top right corner)
- 2. Click Settings, scroll to Autofill section, click Passwords
 - Uncheck Offer to save passwords
 - o Uncheck Auto Sign-in
- 3. Under Saved Passwords, find the site that needs to be removed
 - Click the three dots to the right of the site > Remove
- 4. **Click** back button next to Passwords, **scroll** to Privacy and Security section
 - Click Clear browsing data > Advanced
 - Check Passwords and Other Sign-in Data and Autofill form data
 - Click Clear Data



- 1. Open browser, click Safari in the program menu
- 2. **Select** Preferences from the drop-down menu
 - a. Click Autofill Tab
- 3. To stop the browser from saving usernames or passwords
 - a. Uncheck Usernames and Passwords
- 4. To remove specific usernames and passwords, click Edit
 - a. Select the site to be removed
 - i. Click Remove> Done

Microsoft Edge



- 1. Click More button
- 2. **Select** Settings
 - o To remove specific usernames and passwords, **click** Profile
 - Turn off Saved Passwords
 - Click Manage Passwords
 - Click the X next to the site to be removed
 - o To remove all saved usernames and passwords, click Privacy and Security
 - Under Clear Browsing Data, select Choose What to Clear
 - Select Autofill Data
 - **Click** the Clear button

Andriod Device

Steps to completed will depend on the operating system of your Android device, if the steps below don't work consider using the search option after accessing the Settings app

- 1. **Open** Settings app
- 2. **Select** System > Languages and Input > Autofill Service
 - Click the gearwheel for Autofill Service
 - Click Passwords
 - Select the site to be removed and click Delete

iPhone Device
