



# One Time Passcode Authenticator

WESTconsin knows security is a big concern to those using Online and Digital Banking options. Using a **One Time Passcode Authenticator** is a 2-step verification process to access your WESTconsin accounts on your mobile device. This process provides stronger security for your accounts by requiring a second step of verification when you sign in, with a time-based code generated by an app on your phone.

## ONE TIME PASSCODE AUTHENTICATOR

Using Google Authenticator or Microsoft Authenticator will replace the step in the login process that typically would require you to receive a call or text message from WESTconsin Credit Union. Instead, the Authenticator App will provide you with a unique and time sensitive code that only you can access. This is a strong security choice because:

1. Receiving codes via text message or phone call is less secure than using an authentication app.
2. You never have to worry about an interruption in text or phone verifications.



## AUTHENTICATOR ENROLLMENT

- ✓ Download Google Authenticator or Microsoft Authenticator from App store
- ✓ Login to your *WESTconsin* Online account > *Settings* > *My Settings* > *Security Options* > *Edit*
- ✓ Flip Authenticator Switch from OFF to ON, enter password, and save changes
- ✓ Once you turn ON the Authenticator Switch, two things need to happen:
  1. Locate the alphanumeric and/or QR code on the *WESTconsin* settings webpage
  2. Open your Authenticator App and enter an Account Name and Secret Key or scan QR code.
    - ✓ Account name can be anything you would like (e.g. a username, *WESTconsin* Credit Union, etc.)
    - ✓ Secret key is the alphanumeric or QR code on the *WESTconsin* settings webpage

## USING THE AUTHENTICATOR

- ✓ After enrolling in the authenticator, depending on your computer or mobile device settings, you may or may not be asked for a one-time passcode when logging into your *WESTconsin* account.
- ✓ If prompted for a one-time passcode, the option to enter your authenticator code will be last on the secure login screen.
- ✓ Choose the authenticator option, retrieve code in the authenticator app, and enter it during the *WESTconsin* login process.
